- Provide technical oversight and professional review of Gophelega activities that leverage data analytics, machine learning, and predictive analytics.
- Serve as technical and subject matter authority in the management of data and analytics requirements, policies, procedures, and tools to ensure the confidentiality, integrity, and availability of quality data.
- Facilitate discussion among key staff to articulate a vision and plan for integrating data science into planning, delivering, and assessing health and development programs.
- Participate in the negotiation of data-user agreements with the DoH, Donor and other external stakeholders.
- Prepare guidance for implementing teams and M&E teams to data capture, storage, curation, transfer/entry, and quality.
- Participate and lead Site Improvement through Monitoring System (SIMS) visits to facility, community, and above-site sites.

- Assess the quality of data and improving the dataset by removing or cleaning the data.
- Pulls and integrates data from disparate sources
- Evaluates and processes raw information
- Merges complex data
- designs, codes, debugs, tests, documents, and supports server-based applications such as SQL
- Leads and oversees reporting in donor health information systems e.g., DATIM.
- Ensures timely submission to donors and to outside other stakeholders
- Ensures data submitted is set up as per agreed specs with different stakeholders
- Analyse broad data sets to provide actionable insights to better inform Wits RHI decisions.
- Performing analysis to assess quality and meaning of data.
- Use statistical tools to identify, analyse and interpret patterns and trends in complex data sets.
- Prepare analysis reports for the key stakeholders to understand the analysis process and outcomes, allowing them to take informed decisions.
- Develops clear and well-structured analytical plans and analyses large data-sets inclusive of facility data and donor reported data
- Present and explain information in an accessible way e.g., reports
- Creates and maintains analytic dashboards for various programmes
- Pro-actively identifies analytic needs for the various programs and provides the needed support.
- Delves into data to identify discrepancies and patterns and shares this information with relevant stakeholders and teams.
- Take ownership and accountability for tasks and demonstrates effective self-management
- Follow through to ensure that quality and productivity standards of own work are consistently and accurately maintained
- Maintain a positive attitude and respond openly to feedback
- Take ownership for driving own career development by participating in on-going training and development activities such as conferences, workshops etc.
- Take ownership of the running and management of the WITS RHI data hub.

Required minimum education and training

- Honours degree (master's preferred) in Data Science, Health Informatics, Statistics, Applied Mathematics, Computer science, or any other related field.

Desirable additional education, work experience and personal abilities

- Excellent analytical and problem-solving skills. Positive and energetic team leader.
- Ability to adapt to complex situations, manage stress and deliver goals pro-actively.
- Organized with a thorough and accurate approach to work, attention to detail.

Required minimum work experience

- At least 5 years in a data analyst position, preferably working as a Data Analyst in public Health, NGO funded organisations and DOH.
- Proficiency in SQL, Python, visualization, and analysis tools. Experience in data analysis and visualization methods required.
- Ability to extract, transform and load data.
- Experience working with large data sets that are complex data.
- Experience working in donor driven programmes is desirable.
- Experience with the DHIS, Tier.Net, DATIM, SynCH and other DoH/ Donor data systems.
- Leadership skills with proven experience managing a small team.
- Experience in donor and DoH reporting, writing reports for internal use and for external stakeholders.
- Demonstrated ability to build capacity of the public health multidisciplinary teams.
- Ability to get along with and work with people on different levels and from different cultures.

Demands of the job

- Local travel and working overtime will be required.
- Must be able to work in time constrained, highly pressurized deadline driven environments.

Communications and relationships

- Excellent communication skills (both written and oral) in English.
